Инструкция по выполнению работы

Устная часть КИМ ЕГЭ по английскому языку включает в себя 4 задания.

Задание 1 – чтение вслух небольшого текста научно-популярного характера.

В задании 2 предлагается ознакомиться с ситуацией и задать 4 вопроса на основе ключевых слов.

В задании 3 предлагается дать интервью на актуальную тему, развёрнуто ответив на пять вопросов.

В задании 4 предлагается проблемная тема для проектной работы, в рамках которой необходимо дать описание и сравнение, а также выразить своё мнение по проблеме проектной работы с опорой на план.

Общее время проведения экзамена для одного экзаменуемого – 45 минут.

Ограничений по времени подготовки и ответа на каждое задание нет, за исключением задания 3.

Каждое последующее задание выдаётся после окончания выполнения предыдущего задания. Всё время ответа ведётся аудио- и видеозапись.

Постарайтесь полностью выполнить поставленные задачи, старайтесь говорить ясно и чётко, не отходить от темы и следовать предложенному плану ответа. Так Вы сможете набрать наибольшее количество баллов.

Task 1. Imagine that you are preparing a project with your friend. You have found some interesting material for the presentation and you want to read this text to your friend. Read the text silently, then read it out aloud.

Frogs have a sticky tongue. They use it to catch and swallow food. Unlike humans, their tongue is not attached to the back of its mouth. Instead, it is attached to the front. It enables the frog to stick its tongue out much further. Most frogs don't hunt, but wait for their prey to come close enough for them to attack. When it happens, they quickly stick out their tongue and put the prey straight into their mouth. Frogs can't chew their food so they must swallow it whole. Frogs can also jump while hunting. Some kinds of frogs can jump up to 20 times their own body length in a single leap.

As frogs are cold-blooded, they don't need to feed very often. During extreme conditions, some frogs enter a state of low physiological activity and remain inactive for months. In colder regions, many species of frog sleep in winter.
